## The NABCB Accreditation Mark

The NABCB accreditation mark relates to the accreditation of Intertek to award certificates and must only be used in conjunction with the requirements of Conditions for Use of NABCB Accreditation Symbol and other claims of accreditation, IAF MLA Mark and ILAC MRA Mark”- NABCB 010 – May 2026.

### Use of NABCB mark

1. Intertek’s accreditation number (printed centrally under the NABCB mark is part of the mark and must not be excluded from the mark.
2. The size of the logo shall not normally be reduced to below the size 15x12mm. In the event of reproduction in smaller size owing to limitation of space, the logo must be legible with no infilling of space and letters.
3. The mark shall only be printed in the colour combination or in the grey-black combination as specified in the Appendix A.
4. The IAF MLA mark when used under contract with NABCB shall be reproduced and used in accordance with the stipulations in the contract, refer Appendix ‘B’. Intertek can reproduce the mark and any MLA mark only in conjunction with its own certification mark.
5. The mark shall not be used in any way that it misleads the reader about Intertek’s accredited status. When used it should not imply that a product, process, system or person is approved by the accreditation body
6. The NABCB mark cannot be displayed on vehicles, buildings, or flags. It should not be used on the packaging of a product, labels, publicity material, written announcements etc. that in any way suggests that the Intertek or NABCB have certified or approved any product, process or service of the certified client or in any other misleading manner.
7. All quotations and contracts by Intertek having the NABCB mark shall clearly indicate the portion of activities that are not accredited by NABCB.
8. The NABCB mark shall not be used on the visiting cards.
9. The NABCB mark may be displayed on stationery only if Intertek’s mark is also shown; it should not be more prominent than Intertek’s mark.

### **Misuse**

Intertek shall take reasonable action and relevant advise to the concerned organization for corrective action when used in contrary to the conditions specified. In situations of repeated contraventions by certified organization, Intertek may withdraw the certification

In case Intertek does not take suitable action against the improper use of the NABCB Accreditation Mark either by the certified client or own usage, NABCB may suspend / withdraw the accreditation.

### **Action on Suspension / Withdrawal / Termination**

Upon suspension of the accreditation, Intertek shall immediately cease to use its stationery, certificates and other publicity material that has accreditation mark on it. The use can be restarted only after the suspension is revoked.

Upon Withdrawal /Termination of the accreditation Intertek shall immediately cease to use its stationery, certificates and other publicity material that has accreditation mark on it.

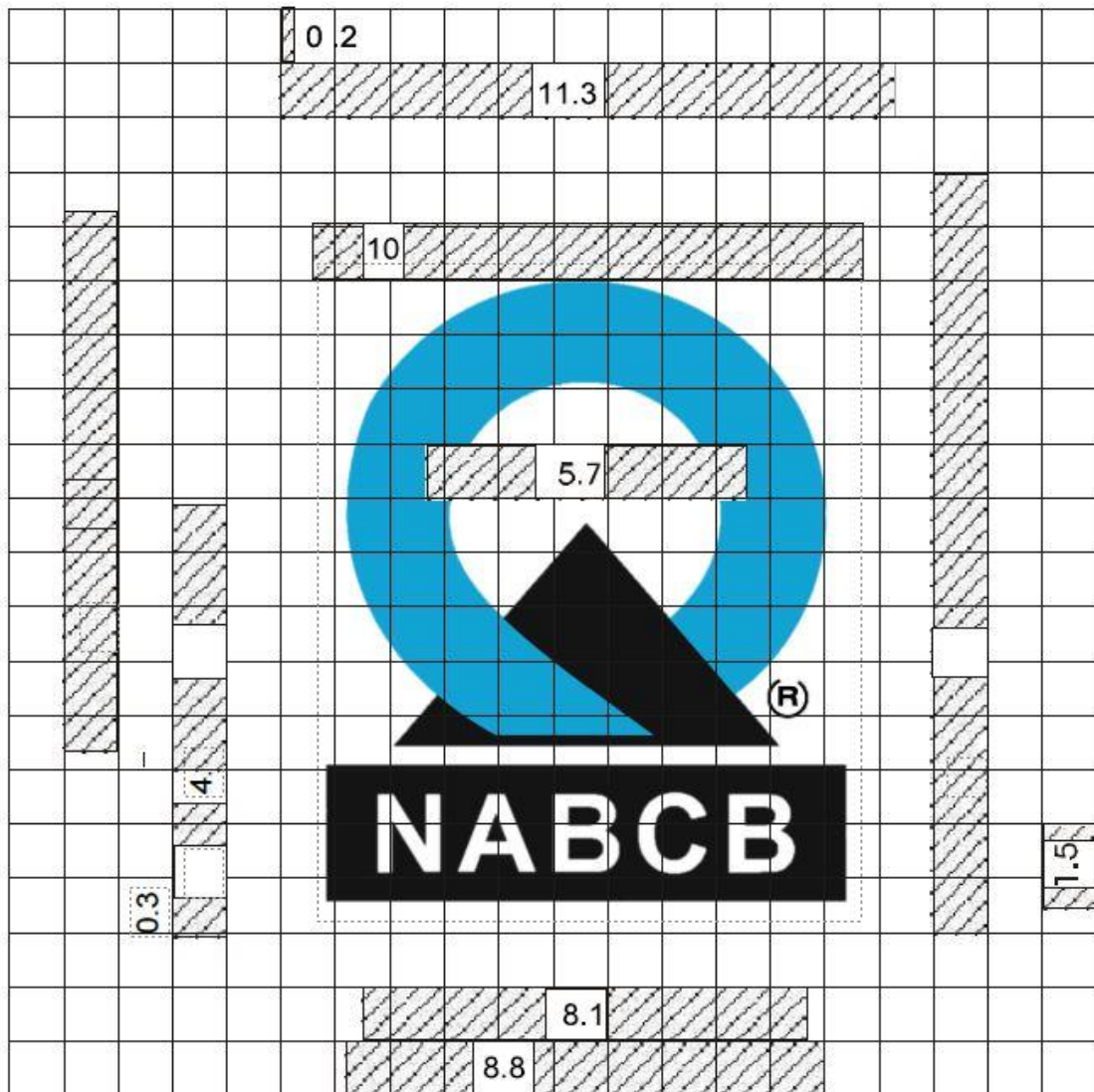
